2nd Sunday in Ordinary Time, Year B (Peace Day)
14th January 2024

READINGS: 1. Samuel 3:3-10.19 2. Corinthians 6:13-15.17-20; Gospel John 1:35-42. Response to Psalm Ps 39:2,4.7-10. Here I am, Lord! I come to do your will. Gospel Acclamation; Alleluia! Alleluia! Speak, Lord, your servant is listening; you have the message of eternal life. Alleluia!

Reflection: On this Second Sunday in Ordinary Time, Year B, the Word of God invites us to be disciples of Jesus. We are reminded that God's call is real and He calls us personally by our names. The first reading recounts the dramatic call of Samuel which reminds us of our own call. Samuel's answers thus: "Speak Lord, your Servant is Listening" is a challenge to our way of life especially praying. Sometimes, our prayer is filled with talking to God, but we live in a noisy world filled with distractions both internally and externally which makes it difficult to listen to God's voice. If only we can discipline ourselves against noise, we will hear the voice of God. The problem is that we are too busy, too noisy and in a hurry, that we hardly have time to hear God's voice. Therefore, we need to create a quiet time and dispose ourselves to listen to God. Can we begin this year by making it a habit to spent at least ten minutes or more in silent prayer without talking?

The gospel presents the beginning of Jesus's ministry and the end of John the Baptist's ministry. John showed Christ to the world thus "Behold the Lamb of God!" We are also called to learn from John by showing Christ to those around us. Finally, God calls us by our names every day with the invitation, "Come, follow me." This invitation to follow Christ requires prompt response. Therefore, like the Psalmist, our response should always be: "Here I am Lord, I have come to do your Will." Peace Be with You!
