

READINGS: 1. Deuteronomy 18:15-20 2. Corinthians 7:32-35; Gospel Mark 1:21-28. <u>Response to Psalm</u> Ps 94:1-2.6-9. O that today you would listen to his voice! Harden not your hearts. <u>Gospel Acclamation</u>; Alleluia! Alleluia! Blessed are you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, for revealing the mysteries of the kingdom to mere children. Alleluia!

<u>Reflection</u>: The power of God's Word is what today's readings captures. In the first reading, the Lord says to Moses, 'I will raise up a Prophet like yourself for them. To him they must listen. In the gospel, Jesus says to the man possessed by an unclean spirit, "Be quiet and come out of him," And the unclean spirit threw the man into convulsions and with a loud cry, went out of him. This made the congregation cry out, "Here is a teaching that is new, and with authority behind it." This is the Word through which everything is created and held together. It is the Word of God which became flesh and dwelt among us and spoke in human language. It is powerful and transformative among believers.

The purpose God sent his Word is to direct our lives according to his Will and to help us live a good and meaningful life. Also, it is the weapon of our warfare against the evil powers that exists in our world. It is also the antidote against the vicissitudes and anxieties of life. A life without the nourishment of the Word of God is like a house built on shallow foundation, which is bound to fall should the wind blow. Unfortunately, the disease of our age is that we are learned in the various sciences of the world which have produced intellectual giants, but we starve our soul of its nourishment which is the Word of God. This has caused many to be lacking, spiritually. Therefore, we are called today to cultivate the practice of listening to the Word of God and mould our lives according to it. Hence, the psalmist admonishes us thus, "O that today you would listen to his voice, harden not your hearts." God loves You!
