5th Sunday of Lent, Year B 17th March 2024

READINGS: 1. Jeremiah 31:31-34 2. Hebrews 5:7-9 Gospel John 12:20-30. Response to Psalm Ps 50:3-4.12-15. A pure heart create for me, O God. <u>Gospel Acclamation</u>; Glory to you, O Christ, you are the Word of God! If a man serves me, says the Lord, he must follow me; wherever I am, my servant will be there too. Glory to you, O Christ, you are the Word of God!

Reflection: When you understand paradox, you are close to the heart of the gospel. A message in which two statements contradict each other but in it lies the truth. Today's gospel underscores thus: "unless a grain of wheat falls on the ground and dies, it remains only a single grain; but if it dies, it yields a rich harvest." Here, we find Jesus speaking about his path to glory through humiliation and the cross. Nothing in human history is so paradoxical as the crucifixion of Jesus Christ. As He was about to undergo the passion of the cross, He sees it as a moment of glorification, thus: "Now the hour has come, for the Son to be glorified." Hence, the Cross reveals what evil we are capable of doing to each other: betrayal, violence and killing.

The cross likewise reveals the best that's within us. It's message is that God loves us and thinks we are worthy. Our humanity has been lifted up because Christ's cross invested it with infinite value. As the worst of our humanity in all its cruelty succeeded in crucifying the best that God gave us, in that monumental act of cruelty and evil, God brought out the best within us. The crucifixion of Christ seemed a crushing defeat, but out of it came the greatest victory that righteousness has ever won. Therefore, Child of God, the paradox of your life finds meaning and fulfilment in the paradox of Christ's passion and death. For in it, God brings good out of evil, glory out of humiliation, and life out of death. This is possible if we can allow God to take control of our life situations. God Loves You!!!
