2nd Sunday of Easter, Year B (Divine Mercy) 7th April 2024

READINGS: 1. Acts 4:32-35 2. First John 5:1-6 Gospel John 20:19-31. Response to Psalm Ps 117:2-4.15-18.22-24. Give thanks to the Lord for he is good, for his love has no end. Gospel Acclamation; Alleluia, Alleluia! Jesus said: You believe because you can see me. Happy are those who have not seen and yet believe. Alleluia!

Reflection: Today being the 2nd Sunday of Easter and known as 'Divine Mercy Sunday', we find the Apostles dispirited after the death of Jesus. They locked themselves in a room out of fear. Suddenly, Jesus appeared among them and says: "Peace be with you..." Here, Jesus reconciled his failed disciples to Himself and so their hearts were filled with joy. Having experienced the gift of forgiveness, they were sent out to offer to others the gift they had received: "Receive the Holy Spirit, those whose sins you forgive, they are forgiven." Hence the Sacrament of Reconciliation is a privileged moment when we receive the Lord's forgiveness and we extent that forgiveness to others. Let us see the confessional as where we receive forgiveness and grace.

Thomas was not with the disciples when the Lord appeared and missed out on the gift of peace and forgiveness. He seems to have cut himself off from the community. When we cut ourselves off from the community of believers, we lose out greatly. Despite all its flaws, the Church is a place where we encounter the risen Lord especially when we gather and pray with one heart and mind like the disciples. The disciples reached out to Thomas and shared their joy with him: "We have seen the Lord." This reminds us of our duty to keep reaching out to those who have drifted away from the Church. Their effort and Jesus' visit made Thomas to grow from doubt to faith. On this, Thomas Merton wrote: "Faith is not a suppression of doubt. It is the overcoming of doubt, and you overcome doubt by going through it. The person of faith who has never experienced doubt is not a person of faith."
