+ 4TH SUNDAY OF ADVENT, YEAR C

"Blessed are you among women, and blessed is the Fruit of *your womb.*" (Luke 1.42)

The Church is noted for her staunch devotion and honour to Virgin Mary. Every day we offer to God by invoking her maternal intercession the most efficacious devotional prayer, the 'Hail Mary'. In doing so, we are far from being misguided, contrary to what many people, including some Christians, think. A look at the 'Hail Mary' itself shows why we are perfectly right. When we say, 'Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with you', we only repeat archangel Gabriel's greeting to Mary (Lk 1.28). In saying, 'Blessed are you among women, and blessed is the Fruit of your womb, Jesus', we recall the exclamation made loudly of Mary by Elizabeth under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit (Lk 1.41-42). As we say, 'Holy Mary, mother of God', we affirm three truths: (a) the sanctity of Mary which no sane person can deny; (b) the divinity of Christ amply and explicitly stated in Sacred Scripture (Is 7.14; 9.6; Mt 1.23; Jn 1.1,18; 5.18; 8.57-58; Rom. 9.5; Phil. 2.6; Col. 2.9; etc.); and (c) as the mother of Christ who is God, Mary is the mother of God who is Christ (Council of Ephesus, 325 AD). When we say lastly, 'Pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death', we admit: (a) our fallen humanity that is wrapped in sinfulness which no one can deny without being hopelessly self-delusional (1 Jn 1.8-9); (b) Mary's ability to mediate with Christ for the faithful even without their asking, and to obtain from God what she seeks for them (Jn 2.3-11); and (c) our constant reliance on every help we can get due to our mortality and perpetual weakness till we die. So to honour Mary is not to do anything strange or unlawful, but simply to consent to what God Himself. Christ who chose to be born of Mary, the angelic hosts, the prophets, and the patriarchs and matriarchs have all done and revealed. We acknowledge her unique place and role in our salvation, given her by God from eternity, specifically after the catastrophic fall of Adam and Eve (Gen. 3.15), and affirmed in prophecy (Is 7.14). The human race that fell from grace due to the fault of the woman, Eve (Gen. 3.1-7), was to be restored to grace through the faith and the Offspring of the woman, Virgin Mary (Lk 1.26-38).
