+ 5TH SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME – YEAR A

“You are salt of the earth; you are the light of the world.” (Mt 5.13,14)

Today is **Racial Justice Sunday**. Its theme, ‘You are the heart of the Church’, was taken from Pope Paul VI’s 1965 homily at a Roma site in Pomezia, Italy. This year’s focus is on the contributions to the Church in England and Wales of the Travelling Communities, including the Irish Travellers, and the Gypsies or Roma. By this, the Church: (a) draws our attention to the discrimination and ill-treatment Travellers historically suffer in the whole of Europe both ‘in the wider society and, sadly, in the Church’; (b) celebrates their contributions in our parishes; (c) encourages other members of the Church to be more open and welcoming to them. It should be recalled that Gypsies were also victims of genocide during World War II, with the number of those killed estimated by later research to be up to 1.5 million. The hope is that Christians will change their attitudes to and treatment of the Travellers. “The time has come,” Pope Francis says, “to put an end to age-old prejudices, preconceptions and mutual mistrust that are often at the base of discrimination, racism and xenophobia. No one must feel isolated, and no one is authorised to trample on the dignity and rights of others.” In light of this, the Church calls on all to: (a) challenge hate speech and discrimination against Gypsy, Roma, and Traveller Communities; (b) welcome Gypsy, Roma, and Traveller parishioners as sisters and brothers in Christ; (c) work to ensure that appropriate sites and facilities are provided for them in our local areas. “In Christ, there cannot be Jew or Greek . . . for you are all one in Christ Jesus” (Gal. 3.28; Col. 3.11; Rom. 10.12).
