CORONAVIRUS OUTBREAK: CURRENT GUIDELINES

Please note the following guidelines from the Bishops Conference of England and Wales, and from Cardinal Vincent Nicols:

- 1. Public Sunday and weekday Mass in the parish has been suspended till further notice. In the present difficult circumstance, the obligation to attend especially Sunday Mass does not apply.
- 2. The parish clergy will continue to celebrate Mass in the church on **weekdays at 9.30 am** and on **Sunday at 9.00 am**, but without the congregation. Parishioners are invited to join in spirit from their homes or wherever they may be, and make an Act of Spiritual Communion;
- 3. The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed on Saturday from 10.30 am till 12.00 noon, and on Sunday from 9.40 am till 12.00 noon for adoration and private prayers;
- 4. Mass in some parishes will be streamed live. See the second notice for the times and links of the parishes;
- 5. The church will remain open every day as usual, for private prayers;
- 6. All group activities in the parish, including Stations of the Cross and meetings, are suspended till further notice;
- 7. There will be no Baptisms until the public health advice allows for the gathering of people;
- 8. First Holy Communion classes are suspended, and this may affect the date of this year's First Holy Communion;
- 9. The priests are available for Confessions on request only;
- 10. Pastoral visits to the sick, whether at home, or in a hospital, or in a care centre, are suspended till further notice;
- 11. Funeral services may be held at the graveside or crematorium, subject to the guidelines that obtain at the cemetery or crematorium;
- 12. Please offer a generous and prompt response to anyone around you who may be in need, especially the vulnerable, observing the public health advice in that regard;
- 13. Guidelines about the Easter ceremonies will be forthcoming;
- 14. Please, collect a copy of the Cardinal's pastoral letter in the porch;
