"O you of little faith, why did you doubt?" (Mt 14.31)

The Scripture defines Faith as "the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen" (Heb. 11.1). By faith, we rationally accept "with no doubting" (Jam. 1.6) that certain propositions are absolutely true. Our certainty comes, not from us or from anything that is within the reach of our natural vision, but from the truthfulness of God Who can neither deceive nor be deceived. Faith is, thus, the fruit of grace given to us, not by "flesh and blood", but by the Father Who is in heaven' (Mt 16.17; cf. Mt 11.25). In this sense, faith enables us to accept with total conviction everything that God has revealed. The same faith enables us to commit ourselves wholly to God, to trust Him with all our heart, and to resign ourselves completely to Him, that He may work in us, and through us, in order to accomplish His kind purposes for us. The grace of this faith transcends our nature and enables us to do extraordinary things that are totally above that nature. With it, we can walk on water, as St Peter in today's gospel did (cf. Mt 14.29); we can heal the sick only by laying our hands on them (Mk 16.18); we can move mountains (Mt 17,20-21), and command the sycamine tree to be uprooted and planted in the sea, and it would obey us (Lk 17.6); we can raise the dead to life, as did St Peter (cf. Acts 3.36-42); we can even stop the sun from setting, as did Joshua (Jos. 10.10-15), or the rain from falling for years (cf. 1 Kg 17.1). Indeed, with faith, 'we can do all things in Him who strengthens us' (Phil. 4.13). On the other hand, in the absence of this faith and the help from above that goes with it, we are confined to the limits that our nature imposes, and even for us to do the ordinary things of life will be with considerable difficulties.
