# + $21^{ST}$ SUNDAY - YEAR A

"But who do you say that I am?" (Matthew 16.15)

We all have our worlds we live. Sometimes, those worlds are either partially or fully closed to others; unless we open them up, no one may know what we really have in them. Getting to know someone, especially being let into the person's inner, and perhaps secret, world is a great privilege that can also be challenging, as it is exciting. And being allowed to share in that person's world is even a greater privilege undeserved, something that should always be appreciated and treasured. Just as we owe the utmost respect for everything we know about a person from sharing in their world, we equally owe it as a duty to know them for who they truly are, and not to impose our prejudiced perception on them. To be able to do that, we need to contemplate and pay close attention to them, and let our perception of them be shaped by the truth of who they are. It appears that most of the people who encountered Our Lord during His earthly life all misunderstood Him for Who He was. They regarded Him as a blasphemer and an imposter (Jn. 10.33), a lawbreaker (Jn 9.16; 5.16,18), a sinner (Jn 9.24), a perverter of the nation (Lk 23.2), and an evildoer (Jn 18.30) Who deserved nothing but a shameful execution. Thankfully, there were some people (including St Peter, the first disciple) who recognised Him - though dimly - for Who He is, but not by their own insight. It was revealed to them by the Father through the Holy Spirit (Mt 16.17), for "no one knows the Son except the Father" (Mt 11.27), and "no one can say 'Jesus is Lord' except by the Holy Spirit" (1 Cor. 12.3). Those who received that gift of the Father are thus able to profess Him to be the Christ, the Son of the living God (Mt 16.16), as well as our Lord and our God (Jn 20.28).
