"Take heed, watch and pray, for you do not know when the time will come." (Mark 13.33)

Blessed be our great God and most loving Father Who has brought us safely to the beginning of yet another liturgical year, despite the troubles of the past one. Thanks to the right decisions and actions of the government, and to the cooperation of most citizens, we will be returning to our community worship during the week. It also appears that we will be celebrating the year's Christmas communally, unlike what happened at Easter. In hope and with great expectation, we look forward to this. As we start today to prepare to welcome with joy the grace, the peace, the regeneration, and the transformation, that came with the birth of Our Lord, and as we look forward to the completion of our salvation when He returns in glory, we ought to rejoice. But our rejoicing should be measured, for we do not yet possess the fullness of glory. At this time of the year, most trees are without foliage; they are bare and appear to be dead; yet they are alive, and they await the new life that comes with Spring. In a similar way, when we look at the current calendar year that is passing away, we see reflected in our collective experience what the Scripture has said concerning us: "We are afflicted in every way, but not crushed; perplexed, but not driven to despair; persecuted, but not forsaken; struck down, but not destroyed; always carrying in the body the death of Jesus, so that the life of Jesus may also be manifested in our mortal flesh" (2 Cor. 4.8-11). All the uncertainty and anxiety, the pain and distress, the barrenness of the times we live in, should point us to the glory that will be revealed in us if in all our troubles we stand with the Lord, firm in Him.

The diocese encourages a voluntary offering of £10 for each Mass intention.

<u>Gift Aid Form</u>: If you are a UK taxpayer, the church can claim from the government 25% of your contribution to it at no extra cost

to you. All you need to do is sign the Gift Aid Form. Also, due to the risks involved in cash handling, please consider making your contribution to the parish by Standing Order. To do so, also complete the section in the Gift Aid Form and return it to the parish office. The form is on the tables in the entrance and the exit porches.
