+ HOLY FAMILY SUNDAY – YEAR B

“The parents of Jesus took up to Jerusalem.” (Lk 2.22)

The family is the oldest human institution. It is the original cell of social life where a man and a woman, united in marriage, are called to mutually communicate themselves in love and transmit life. Its origin goes back to the moment God first created man and woman and established them in a permanent union, endowing them with the generative power, blessing them, and ordering them to propagate the human species (Gen. 1.27-28). Forming a family is thus the natural and primary vocation of all; everyone has a natural right to it, and only a higher call “for the sake of the kingdom” (Mt 19.10-12) can override the right. This institution was constituted a sacrament by the Lord Himself when, by His actual presence, He graced an instance of its formalisation at Cana. On that occasion, He performed the first miracle of His public ministry, although, then, His “hour has not yet come” (Jn 2.1-11). The family of the Christian is also a ‘domestic Church’ (*Lumen Gentium*, 11) called to be a community of faith, hope, and charity, and finding its true meaning in the Holy family of Nazareth. As the sign and image of ‘the communion of the Father and the Son in the Spirit,’ it is a privileged community that in childbearing and childrearing reflects the Father’s creative work, and creates an affinity of feelings, thoughts, affections, and interests. The ‘authority, stability, and life of relationships’ within it are the foundations of freedom, security, and fraternity in society. In it is provided education in the virtues (including self-denial, sound judgement, and self-mastery, which are preconditions for true freedom), and in the authentic human values of love, tenderness, respect, forgiveness, fidelity, love of truth, disinterested service, etc., initiating children into solidarity and communal responsibility (cf. *Catechism*, 2201-2207). In its integrity it ought to be respected, protected, and fostered by all.
