+ 5TH SUNDAY OF EASTER – YEAR B

I am the vine; you are the branches. (John 15.5)

The powerful metaphor of the vine and its branches is used by Our Lord to explain the way He is related to us, and we are related to Him. Naturally, the vine pre-exists its branches, and the branches only grow out of the vine and on it, and they depend on it for everything, including their very existence and entire life. Through the vine, every branch has its being, and not a single branch exists except through Him (Jn 1.3). The vine can subsist without the branches, but the branches cannot subsist apart from the vine; without the vine, they are totally dead (Jn 15.6). The vine in our own case is not only a living being, but also a life-generating force, the life-giving Spirit (1 Cor. 15.45); He gives life to anyone He chooses (Jn 5.21). Just as this vine is the source of all life, it is also the source of all fruitfulness and good action; without it, the branches are utterly sterile (Jn 15.4) . . . *for apart from Me, you can do nothing* (Jn 15.5). The vine from which the branches arise is the final end to which they tend, since *all things were created through Him and for Him* (Col. 1.16). In the vine alone do the branches all have their meaning and fulfilment. What all this means for us is that we do not, and cannot, live or exist, do anything, or live a meaningful life, apart from the Lord, the true Vine (Jn 15.1). We may not be conscious of it, let alone always, but it is only *in Him* that *we live and move and have our being* (Acts 17.28). As our entire life and existence, and its every single moment wholly depend on Him, so our principal task is that we be conscious of our total dependence on the Lord for everything, and that we let that consciousness determine all our life and actions in response to the reality of our utter dependence on Him.
