+ HOLY TRINITY SUNDAY – YEAR B

Baptise them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. (Matthew 28.19)

The doctrine of the Most Blessed Trinity is explicitly affirmed by the Lord Himself in His last instructions where He charges the disciples to “go and make disciples of all nations, baptising them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, of the Holy Spirit.” (Mt 28.19). In this charge, He distinguishes between the Person of the Father, the Person of the Son, and the Person of the Holy Spirit, while placing the three divine Persons on a par. The three divine Persons came together and witnessed to the Lord at His baptism, with the Holy Spirit descending on the Lord in the visible form of a dove, and the Father publicly testifying to the Lord as His Beloved Son (Mt 3.16-17; Lk 3.22). The Trinity is invoked in 1 Cor. 12.4-6 where the Holy Spirit is described as the source of all gifts in the Church, the Lord as the One to Whom all services are due, and the Father as the One Who inspires all good works. The Trinity is again invoked in 2 Cor. 13.14 by the “grace of Our Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit”. The singleness of the Spirit, of the Lord Jesus, and of the Father is referenced to underline Christian unity (cf. Eph. 4.4-6). The divinity of the Father is never in doubt. The divinity of Christ was veiled in His humanity; it was acknowledged explicitly in the gospel (Jn 1.1-2; 10.33; Col. 2.9; Phil. 2.6) and had to be revealed to faith. The Son is equal to the Father (Jn 5.18), and one and the same God with Him (Jn 10.30; 17.11, 21; 14.9-10; 8.58; Col. 1.15); while the Holy Spirit is the Spirit both of the Father (Jn 15.26) and of Christ the Lord (Rom. 8.9; Gal. 4.6; 1 Pt 1.11).
