+ PENTECOST SUDAY – YEAR B

They were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues. (Acts 2.4)

Our blessed mother was acclaimed by angel Gabriel to be *full of grace* (Lk 1.28). Of all human beings, she alone, and no other person, has ever been so acclaimed. Being so full, she had in her no space for anything other than grace. Her entire life, her thoughts, words, actions, feelings, and attitudes were all completely under the influence of grace. So she was the perfect *handmaid of the Lord* ever totally disposed to do the will of God (Lk 1.38). Similar to her experience, the disciples were said at Pentecost to be *filled with the Holy Spirit* (Acts 2.4), a particular form of divine intervention in human life that marks the new life of grace and is the unique experience of true believers. This experience flows from that of the Lord Who was *full of the Holy Spirit* (Lk 4.1). It fulfils His promise to give to believers that water which would become in them *rivers of living water* (Jn 7.38-39) *welling up to eternal life* (Jn 4.14). It is intended to be an experience of the Holy Spirit permanently dwelling in the believer (Jn 14.16-17) whom the Spirit has claimed and sealed as His own (Eph. 1.13). All who are filled by the Spirit (Eph. 5.18) are called upon to live and walk by the Spirit (Gal. 5.16, 25). They should also be led by the Spirit (Gal. 5.18; Rom. 8.14), just as in His life, the Lord was *impelled* by the same Spirit (Mk 1.12; Mt 4.1). They are to be guided by the Spirit into all truth (Jn 16.13), and equipped with varieties of gifts freely and readily made available to them for the Christian service (1 Cor. 12.4-7). By making proper use of those gifts under the guidance and power of the Spirit, they will produce the appropriate fruits of the Spirit (Gal. 5.22-25).

New PSR: Seena Vadassery has been appointed our new Parish Safeguarding Representative by the diocese. We thank her for accepting to serve our parish community in that capacity. She will be joined by two others. Please direct to her from now on all your safeguarding issues.

New Lockdown Guidelines:

- The church will now be open for private prayers till 7pm each day. Users are advised to follow all the relevant Covid protocols in place.
- Offertory Collection & Procession can now resume at the proper times during Mass.
- Children's Liturgy and catechetical activities inside the church can now resume.
- Prayers of the Faithful can be re-introduced.
- You may touch, but do not kiss, statues in veneration.
- Servers can assist at Mass, and incense and candles can be used.
- Sign of Peace remains suspended.
- Communion under one kind only.
- People can receive Communion on the tongue, but only after everyone else has received.
- A choir of up to 6 persons can sing, but

singing by the congregation remains suspended..

- Up to 30 persons may attend a Baptism, Confirmation, Marriage, or Funeral ceremony.
- Safe visits to the sick and housebound may now resume.
- Face covering to worn at all times inside the church

Youth Ministry: The newly launched St Peter's and Marychurch Youth Club has still a few places left. Initially the Youth Club will be online until Covid restrictions are lifted and will then take place at St. Peter's Church Hall. We start at 5.00 pm for up to a 45 mins session.

We will be running quizzes, show and tell, drama and many more games. There will be no charge when we run the Club online, although there will be a small token charge when we start the programme in the Hall. This opportunity is open to all Year 4 and Year 5 pupils.
