## **+ ASSUMPTION OF BLESSED VIRGIN MARY**

***As in Adam all die, so also in the Lord shall all be made alive.*** (1 Cor. 15.22)

By the decree, *Munificentissimus Deus* of 1 November 1950, Pope Pius XII defined the Assumption of Blessed Virgin as a dogma, that is, an article of our faith. The dogma affirms these truths: (a) at the end of her earthly life, Mary the virgin mother of God was assumed body and soul into heaven, to be more fully conformed to her Son, *the Lord of lords, conqueror of sin and death* (LG, 58); (b) Mary's assumption is her singular participation in the resurrection of the Lord, and an anticipation of the resurrection of all the elect; (c) her assumption led to her glorification by which she is exalted as queen over all things (CCC, 966); she is thus the woman who was *clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars* (Rev. 12.1). In His Body that He took from Virgin Mary at His Incarnation, the Lord was put to death (1 Pt 3.18). In that Body also, He rose again (Jn 20.20,27), since it was impossible for Him to be held by the pangs of death (Acts 2.24) or suffer corruption in His Body (Acts. 2.27; Ps 16.10). His resurrection was that of the *first fruits of all who fall asleep* (1 Cor. 15.20), meaning that by Himself rising from the dead, He paved the way for all who die in Him to rise again (1 Cor. 15.21-23; 2 Tim. 2.11). With the same Body also, albeit now glorified (cf. Phil. 3.21), He ascended into heaven as the disciples watched (Acts 1.9). In a pre-eminent way, and more than anyone else, Mary was united to the Lord in His death and resurrection, just as being His mother, she was inseparably united to Him in His earthly life. In the same way, she is now in her body and soul united to Him in His glory in heaven.
