. What God has joined together, Man must not divide. Mk. 10:9”

Marriage is honourable, but the marriage of Eve to Adam as come down to us from Gen 2:21-25 is by every consideration the most honourable marriage that ever was, in which God himself had all along an immediate involvement. Marriages, it is said, are made in heaven; we are sure this one was, for the man, the woman, their match, were all God's own immediate work. By his power, he made them both, and then by his ordinance, he made them one (Mk. 10:9, Matt. 19:6). This was a marriage made in perfect innocence, and so was never any marriage since. God brought the woman to the man, having made her from a rib taken from the man, not out his head so she could rule over him, or out of his feet to be trampled upon by him, but out of his side to be to be equal with him, under his arm to be protected, and near his heart to be beloved. God gave Adam a help-mate. Thus, a wife that is of Gods making by special grace, and of Gods bringing by special providence, is likely to prove a worthy help-mate for the husband. Adam's reception of Eve upon waking up from his deep sound sleep is even more endearing. This is at last, 'bone from my bone, flesh from my flesh'. To further appreciate God's love, he gave her a name that is common to her sex; She shall be called woman (*Isha in Hebrew, meaning she-man*) differing from man in sex only, not in nature for she was made from man and now joined to him. It has been said that sabbath and marriage were two ordinances instituted in perfect innocence, the first for the preservation of the church, the second for the preservation of the world of humankind. Jesus in today's gospel as in Matt 19:4-5, reveals that whether it be through Adam's words in Gen 2:23 or through Moses the pen-man, it was the voice of God saying "A man must leave his relations, to cleave to his wife" and so lays down this law to all posterity. The nature of the bonds created by divine ordinances is here portrayed as stronger than those of nature; for to whom can we be more firmly bound than the father that begat us and the mother that bore us? Yet, the son and the daughter must quit those relations and be bound together in Love as one (Psalms 45:10-11). The need therefore, both of prudence and prayer in the making of the choice of this relation is here highlighted. It is said, 'that had need be well done which is to be done for life'.
