"Leave me, Lord; I am a sinful man." Lk. 5:8

Peter and his companions were completely overcome by the enormity of the catch they made after casting their net in obedience to Christ's word. This came after a whole night of futile toil. In the presence of such perfection and glory, Peter's uncleanness became more pronounced. This is reminiscent of Isaiah's reaction when he encountered the glory and Holiness of God (Is 6:3-8). His vision of the Triple-Holy God, seated upon the throne of glory in the Temple is a clear expression of the daunting otherness of the one whose glory feels the whole earth. Isaiah's reaction was one of acute awareness of his uncleanness which made him shrink away until he was purged by the cauterisation of his lips. Scripture is replete with indications that God looks at human worthiness differently. St Paul in his first letter to the Corinthians, (1Cor. 1:27) says that "God chose the foolish things of the world to shame the wise; God chose the weak things of the world to shame the strong. In Romans 8:30, St Paul also spoke of "those God predestined and called; those called are also justified and those justified are glorified". In Jesus' time, there were the highly educated priests and scribes in Jerusalem whom Jesus could have won over, men who could preach and instruct much more eloquently than Peter or any other apostle ever could. There were the highly educated and prestigiously positioned Roman officers in Palestine who would more readily command respect and following in the Gentile world. There were Greek philosophers whose very names would add great prestige to the Gospel movement had they been apostles. It is surprising from the perspective of world business standards that Christ chose none of these men. Unrestricted in his choice, Christ chose men from among the unknown and unlettered fishermen of Galilee. In selecting the Apostles, Christ established a new standard for Christian eloquence, personal prestige and suitability for God's honours. Every Christian, like every flower created by God carries a peculiar splendour which helps to accentuate the beauty of others beside it. Christian eloquence is carrying our crosses daily and patiently and offering a hand when needed.

SPECIAL NOTICE: The parish will be ordering new boxes of offeroty envelopes this coming month. A number of parishioners are already using them, and together with completing a gift aid form, this can boost the value of offerings by 25% if one pays UK income tax. So far, the chancellor has not meddled with the scheme. In order to benefit from gift aid, the parish must keep a record of what parishioners give and this record is kept confidential. The recording is done in one of two ways: 1. By completing a bankers order form in favour of St Peters Parish Hatfiled, or 2. By using numbered offertory envelops each Sunday.

Please, this does NOT involve people giving more than they do already. The extra money comes from the Inland Revenue as it supports all charitable organizations through the gift aid scheme.

In the last "normal year" (2019), gift aid raised an extra £7,000 for the parish. If you are interested, see PAT in the back porch after mass where you can obtain gift aid declaration/bankers order forms.

As you can imagine, after almost 2 years of lockdowns and other restrictions, it has been a very difficult time for the parish. As we return to a 'new normal' it is vital it has the resources to attend to all the work now requiring attention. Thank you for your attention.
