## PARISH FINANCES

### AUGUST: -£3500 (DEFICIT)

The lockdown has affected many people and charities, and the Parish of Hemel Hempstead East is no exception. From the period of April through to the end of August, we had a **£18000 deficit**. This means we were running on around **£3500 deficit per month**. Projects planned for this year have been put on hold. Every month we will update you on our deficit/surplus status. We will include parishioner planned giving and donations, Hall Rental income and costs incurred. This will be updated below. As we become more aware of our financial situation, and hall rentals increase we hope that we can get back to surplus and start planning to do the works that need to be done in our churches.
