# Courage!

Fr Brian writes...

'Courage! Do not be afraid! Look, your God is coming, he is coming to save you.' ISAIAH 35:4-7. Those words from this Sunday's First Reading should fill us with great hope, as we return to worship, now that the summer has passed. Welcome back! Already, we are seeing an increase in Mass attendance. This is very good to see. I encourage all parishioners to return to Mass. I really can't see any reason to stay away. Can you? We miss you! The heart of our Catholic faith is the corporate celebration of the Eucharist. It is anticipated that the Sunday Obligation will be reinstated on the First Sunday of Advent. But why wait until then? There is much to do as we live our faith as One Body and give witness in our world, whether that is in our workplace, our educational establishments or community groups. I don't need to spell out the details of the great distress the world has gone through since the start of the pandemic. Now it needs to hear the Good News of Jesus Christ and see the witness of his love in us as a gathering of his disciples.

A significant focus for us, along with the Universal Church, will be playing our part in preparing for the two-year 'synodal' process taking place in the Catholic Church from October 2021 that culminates in the final **Synod Gathering of Bishops in Rome in October 2023**. The overall theme is "For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation, Mission". The process begins in each diocese and then moves to the level of the Bishops' Conference of England and Wales. From there, discernment takes place within the European Council of Bishops' Conferences (CCEE) – before moving to the Universal Church with the final Synod Gathering of Bishops in 2023. As part of preparations at a diocesan level each parish will have input. I am hoping that the recently formed Parish Pastoral Council will play a significant role in facilitating our engagement in the process. Watch this space for more information! Please don't let this opportunity to influence how the Church meets the challenge of internal and external change and adaptation pass by. All aboard and make your views known! As we head into autumn the **Season of Creation** is upon us. The Season of Creation is the annual Christian celebration of prayer and action for our common home. The season started on the 1<sup>st</sup> September and ends on the 4<sup>th</sup> October, the Feast of St Francis of Assisi, the patron saint of ecology beloved by many Christian denominations. Perhaps someone amongst us may have read *LAUDATO SI'*, the encyclical letter of Pope Francis on care for our common home, and feel inspired to raise our consciousness of what needs to be done. It could be you!?

Thank you for the excellent work that all our Mass **stewards** have done during the period of the pandemic. It is very much appreciated. Without you, we would not have been able to open the church. Stewards are now no longer required during weekday Masses. It would be appreciated if stewards could continue to provide a friendly-face of welcome at our Sunday Masses, by handing out newsletters and dealing with any general queries etc as well as checking the church after Mass for any lost property. On those occasions when I am away, it would be helpful if you could also help the visiting priest to set up for Mass and then tidy away after Mass has been celebrated, as well as securely locking the church. I will continue to set up for Masses by myself on all occasions.
