TODAY'S MASS

"A voice cries in the wilderness:

Prepare a way for the Lord."

Fr Brian writes....

Background on the Gospel Reading Luke 3:1-6

John preaches repentance and baptizes in the region of the Jordan. The Gospel reading from Luke invites us to consider John the Baptist and his relationship to Jesus. John the Baptist appears in the tradition of the great prophets, preaching repentance and reform to the people of Israel. John baptizes for repentance and for forgiveness of sins, preparing the way for God's salvation. John the Baptist is presented as the figure who bridges the time before Christ and prepares the way for Christ's own ministry. Luke shows that salvation is for all people and situated in world events. Therefore, Luke lists the political and religious leaders at the time of John's appearance in the desert. Salvation is understood as God's breaking into this political and social history. He is as present in it now as he was then. John's preaching of the coming of the Lord is a key theme of the Advent season. As John's message prepared the way for Jesus, we too are called to prepare ourselves for Jesus' coming. We respond to John's message by repentance and reform of our lives. We are also called to be prophets of Christ, who announce by our lives the coming of the Lord, as John did. What needs to change in us, what patterns of sin need to be repented of (perhaps requiring sacramental absolution by a priest) so that we can prepare the way of the Lord?

COVID-19) (Coronavirus): As you will be aware a new Covid variant - Omicron - has been identified, and there are concerns that it could be more infectious and less responsive to vaccines. As responsible citizens we continue to do our bit to control the virus. At the time of writing (Monday 29th November) the wearing of masks in church remains voluntary, but strongly recommended. If you sing it is mandatory. Do continue to use the sanitiser at the entrance to the church. When you

come up for Holy Communion, please remove your mask just before you get to the minister (priest/deacon/EMHC), so that the Lord can be received as reverently as possible, then replace your mask. Whilst it is good to see our community return to the celebration of the Sunday Mass. we need to be mindful of our physical behaviour in church. When coming up for Holy Communion and circulating in the church try as best as you can to give each other space. It is difficult at Boxmoor as there are no side aisles and the church is narrow. If you would prefer some space left next to you on the pew/seat, then do take one of the signs from the desk at the back of the church to indicate that. Please do not leave any items behind, as these will be disposed of as waste, unless they are gold bars or keys to the latest BMW M7! Please take your newsletter away with you as well. Masses will be livestreamed on Sundays at 10.15am and 12pm for the benefit of those who are housebound, or are particularly vulnerable to the virus on account of age or a specific chronic health condition.
