

### TODAY'S MASS

The Spirit of truth will lead you to the complete truth

Fr Brian writes....

This week we return to the liturgical season of Ordinary Time, launching into Week 11 from the platform of another glorious Catholic feast day - The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. This Sunday and next Sunday (Corpus Christi), are designated as solemnities, special days that call our attention to central mysteries of our faith. Today, on the first Sunday after Pentecost, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. This feast invites us to consider what we believe about God, who has revealed himself to us in the Trinity—one God in three persons. The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of the Christian faith and of Christian life. God alone can make it known to us by revealing himself as Father, Son and Holy Spirit. The Incarnation of God's Son reveals that God is the eternal Father and that the Son is consubstantial with the Father, which means that, in the Father and with the Father the Son is one and the same God. The mission of the Holy Spirit, sent by the Father in the name of the Son (Jn 14:26) and by the Son "from the Father" (Jn 15:26), reveals that, with them, the Spirit is one and the same God. "With the Father and the Son he is worshipped and glorified" (Nicene Creed, which we return to use to profess our faith, after Lent and Eastertide.)

The verses of today's Gospel come near the end of Jesus' long discourse at the Last Supper. In the early part of this discourse, as we saw last week on Pentecost, Jesus offers assurances to the disciples. Even though he must leave the disciples, he tells them that they will have a future because of the help he will send them in the Holy Spirit. In this section he focuses more on the shape of the future, which will include Jesus' victory over the world that they will share in. The disciples of Jesus cannot know the future. They can only know that, whatever shape the future takes, they will not have to face it alone. They have the Spirit of Truth, who will continue to provide the teaching of Jesus in the future.

Reading this passage on Trinity Sunday reinforces our understanding of the unity shared by the members of the Trinity. Although the idea of one God in three persons remains a mystery, we have the assurance that, as Jesus and the Father share all, Jesus and the Spirit share all. When we say it is a mystery we mean it is a truth of the faith revealed to us by God that surpasses the powers of natural reason; we give it the assent of faith and express that in our profession of faith in the Creed. Faith is not unreasonable. The mystery of the The Most Holy Trinity is a supernatural truth, one that of its very nature lies above our rational intelligences, which are limited. When we get to heaven it will all be made clear!
