TODAY'S MASS

Your peace will rest on that man

Fr Brian writes....

This Sunday we welcome Fr Emmauel Ahua, who will make a Mission Appeal and collection to assist the essential missionary work of The Spiritans (Holy Ghost Fathers.) The collection will be taken after Mass. Thank you in advance for your generosity.

Background on the Gospel Reading

Today's Gospel begins immediately after the final verse in last Sunday's Gospel. After strong language last week about the difficulties of discipleship, Jesus immediately appoints 72 people to go ahead of him to every town and place he plans to visit, proclaiming that the Kingdom of God is at hand. He sends them in pairs. In the Law of Moses two witnesses were needed for a testimony to be credible. It was probably also a safer way to travel. Jesus admits it will be difficult, that he is sending them out like lambs among wolves. Yet they are to bring nothing with them, not even a money bag or sandals. They are to greet no one on the way so as not to be distracted from their mission. When they enter a house, their message is simply "peace." The response they will receive may be positive or negative. Either way, they are to know that the Kingdom of God is at hand. They are not to demand special treatment but eat and drink whatever is given them. They are to stay in one house and are not to look around for one that provides better accommodations. They are to heal the sick as a sign that the Kingdom of God is at hand for them. Like Jesus' miracles, healing is a sign of the coming of the kingdom. If the town will not receive them, they are to shake the dust from their feet and move on. They have to demonstrate total focus on the mission given to them by Jesus. Jesus makes demands on them. When they return from their journeys, they are rejoicing because their mission has been successful. Demons were under their power because of Jesus' name, who said that he watched Satan fall like lightning. Jesus may have sent the 72 out as lambs among wolves, but at the conclusion of this passage he assures them that they have been given real supernatural power over the enemy and nothing will harm them, not even serpents and scorpions. This power continues today in the baptised and particularly in the sacraments and the ordained ministers of the Church who administer them. But we must remember that a key theme of today's Gospel and last Sunday's Gospel is discipleship—its challenges, its difficulties, and its rewards. Sharing in the mission of Jesus is difficult, but everyone is called to do it, not just some professionals trained for ministry. Even for us today, the harvest is plentiful. We should pray to the master of the harvest to send out workers for his harvest. You are those workers. Will you answer the call?

For the Hemel West parish the First Holy Communion Programme 2022-2023, for children in year 3, will open on Tuesday 5 July and close on Sunday 31 July. A link to the online registration will be provided via the Hemel West parish website e-alert system on Tuesday 5 July. There will be an introductory meeting for parents (not children) on Tuesday 13 September in the Parish Centre, Boxmoor between 7.30pm and 9pm, to explain the details of the programme. including dates, times and location of the preparation sessions for parents and children. Questions about the programme will only be answered then and not before, so please avoid ringing or emailing the parish at this stage. It is essential that if your child is to make their First Holy Communion in the summer of 2023, then at least one parent attends the meeting. Holy Communion Masses will take place provisionally on the weekend of the 15/16 July 2023. Places will be allocated. The numbers of guests allowed will be notified once we know how many children are on the programme.

Please note that only children living within the parish of Hemel West will be permitted onto the Hemel West parish First Holy Communion programme, or those children whose parents live elsewhere and are known to me, Fr Brian, and have consistently attended Mass at the Hemel West parish churches i.e. SS Mary & Joseph and St Mark. The parish boundary map will also be published at the time registration 'goes live' so that you can check which parish you are resident in, should there be doubt.
