CHURCH SECURITY BARRIER: There is no need to move the barrier posts in the church from their location, to do so defeats their purpose. Please leave them where they have been placed and avoid moving them so that there are no gaps either side. They only need to be moved for cleaner access. The retractable safety belt just needs to be lifted up from its connector. It will then retract with very little assistance into the barrier post of origin. To re-secure the safety belt the end of Mass, just pull the retractable safety belt out of a barrier post and stretch it across to the opposite barrier post, sliding it down on a connecting point. The accompanying sign should then be placed in front of the security barrier. I will not patronise you by offering in-person or online training sessions, as practice makes perfect!
