WEDNESDAY WEEKDAY MASS: A reminder that as from Wednesday 2 November (All Souls Day) the Wednesday Mass during term-time will be at 1.30pm at St Mark's church in the grounds of the John F Kennedy school. Parking is available in the local area. Please be at the main school reception of the school for no later than 1.15pm. From there Callum Moore will escort you down to St Marks for Mass. After Mass there will be hospitality in the parish room, attended by students from the school. Do note that outside of term-time. Mass will revert to 10am at Boxmoor. NOVEMBER THE MONTH OF THE HOLY SOULS: It will be November next week when we remember the Holy Souls who are in Purgatory. Amongst them may be members of our deceased family and friends, just as many of our family and friends may already be in Heaven. The Church commemorates all her faithful children who have departed from this life but have not yet attained the joys of Heaven. Purgatory is not eternal. Its duration varies according to the nature of our particular judgment, immediately following our death. It is a time of mercy to enable us to be purified of all attachments to sin and desire only God himself, so that we may enter Heaven. Our deceased family and friends, if they are in Purgatory, are completely in the hands of God and therefore rely on our prayers for the repose of their souls. I encourage you to write their names on the purple sheets provided and place them directly into the white Parish Prayer Box. The box will be placed at the foot of the altar and remembered at all Masses during November and especially during All Souls Day Masses on Wednesday 2 November, Mary & Joseph. If you would like to make an return the envelope directly to Missio. offering, then please place it in the blue 'how you

can help our parish' envelope, and pop it into the offertory basket or better still use the contactless machine. Please tick the Holy Souls box on the envelope and Gift Aid your donation if you are a taxpayer. An offering of £10 or more is suggested. Please note that it is not necessary to make a donation and your list of names can be put into the white Parish Prayer Box directly, without making an offering using the blue envelope.
