His visit will close the Mass preaching cycle, the first part of **Love In Action (LIA).** We look forward to welcoming him! Mass times **have** changed a little, so that we can accommodate his fatherly presence amongst us. Do keep your eye on the Mass schedule in the newsletter for Sunday 5 March.

Love in Action is a parish 'current of grace' designed to introduce us to the principles of CATHOLIC SOCIAL TEACHING. The Church's social teaching is a rich treasure of wisdom about building a just society and living lives of holiness amidst the many challenges of modern society; especially as impacted by COVID and other world affairs. Modern Catholic social teaching has been articulated through a tradition of papal, conciliar, and episcopal documents. At the heart of Catholic Social Teaching are several key themes, which you have been hearing about at very 'high-level' at the time of the homily, backed up with various colour handouts and displays in the church. This weekend, we move into week 5 of the priest's preaching cycle as part of LIA. The topic is The Dignity of Workers. As in previous weeks do take home the handouts. Deliver what you need to your workplaces and neighbours. Please read them. Pray about them with your family to see what the Holy Spirit is saying to you in prayer. Then come to the LIA BIG MEET UP on Tuesday 28 March, in the Parish Centre, Boxmoor 7pm until 9.30pm. Do come! Do note please that any previous dates shared with you are invalid and events will not occur on those previously advertised dates. I have had to juggle a few dates with other events – so check your diaries!

After participating in this **'current of grace'** we will have the tools to reflect on the needs of our community and establish for ourselves a path forward for the increase of the Gospel, as we recover from Covid. This 'current of grace' from the Holy Spirit will be the umbrella focus for all the different projects undertaken by you in the parish and those existing in the wider area, with each of the homiletic topics resonating. All that is currently good and beautiful amongst parish service to the wider community can be incorporated. Nothing is invalid as everything leads us to God. Pope Francis emphasises that it is our duty to work together to bring about a more just and peaceful world: to put **love into action**. We start in our parish!

As I have mentioned over several weeks of homiletic preaching, this is also a 'current of grace' that will result over the years ahead in a time of change in the parish. That is a, change to the parish culture, in terms of what we **do** and **say**: **See-Judge-Act!** It's not a problem if it fails or succeeds, which priest is the parish priest, or who the pope is, or who leaves us for other parishes or joins us, as quite simply: **Colossians 3:23!**

THE MARRIAGE ACT 2022: The Marriage (Minimum Age) Act 2022 was passed by the UK Government on 28 April 2022. The Act comes into force on Monday 27 February 2023. The Act will raise the age of marriage to 18 years in England and Wales to protect children from the scourge of forced marriage. This means that 16 to 17-yearolds will no longer be able to marry under any circumstances, including with parental or judicial consent. It is an offence under the law of England and Wales if he or she carries out "any conduct" which assists the child to enter into marriage before the age of 18 years. It is therefore not permitted, under this Act, for any person who acts on behalf of the Church to engage with a person who petitions for marriage who is not 18 years of age in any form for preparation for, or celebration of, matrimony.
