We are very pleased this weekend to welcome Bishop Paul McAleenan, Area Bishop for Hertfordshire. His visit will close the Mass preaching cycle, the first part of **Love In Action** (LIA). Welcome, Bishop Paul! Please join Bishop Paul McAleenan, in the Parish Centre, Boxmoor after the 8.30am and 10.15am Masses for tea/coffee and refreshments. After this weekend we move onto the second stage of getting together as a parish to look into the future and bring about necessary change.

Love in Action is a parish 'current of grace' designed to introduce us to the principles of **CATHOLIC SOCIAL TEACHING**. The Church's social teaching is a rich treasure of wisdom about building a just society and living lives of holiness amidst the many challenges of modern society; especially as impacted by COVID and other world affairs. At the heart of **Catholic Social Teaching** are several key themes, which you have been hearing about at very 'high-level' at the time of the homily, backed up with various colour handouts and displays in the church. This weekend, we move into week 6 of the preaching cycle as part of LIA. The topic is the **Option for the Poor**.

As in previous weeks do take home the handouts. Deliver what you need to your workplaces and neighbours. Please read them. Pray about them with your family to see what the Holy Spirit is saying to you in prayer. Then come to the LIA BIG MEET UP on Tuesday 28 March, in the Parish Centre, Boxmoor 7pm until 9.30pm. Do come!

After participating in this 'current of grace' we will have the tools to reflect on the needs of our community and establish for ourselves a path forward for the increase of the Gospel, as we recover from Covid. This 'current of grace' from the Holy Spirit will be the umbrella focus for all the different projects undertaken by you in the parish and those existing in the wider area, with each of the homiletic topics resonating. All that is currently good and beautiful amongst parish service to the wider community can be incorporated. Nothing is invalid as everything leads us to God. Pope Francis emphasises that it is our duty to work together to bring about a more just and peaceful world: to put love into action.

As I have mentioned over several weeks of homiletic preaching, this is also a 'current of grace' that will result over the years ahead in a time of change in the parish. That is a, change to the parish culture, in terms of what we **do** and **say: See-Judge-Act!** It's not a problem if it fails or succeeds, which priest is the parish priest, or who the pope is, or who leaves us for other parishes or joins us, as quite simply: **Colossians 3:23!**
