PRADER WILLI SYNDROME MONTH: Prader-Willi Syndrome (PWS) is a rare, complex genetic disorder that affects both males and females from birth and throughout their lives. It causes low muscle tone with consequent motor developmental delays, mild to moderate а learning difficulty. incomplete sexual emotional development, and and social immaturity. which can lead to challenging behaviours. During childhood, an overwhelming and insatiable chronic appetite usually develops which, without rigorous food management and exercise regimes, leads to food seeking, stealing and life-threatening obesity. PWS occurs randomly in about 1:22.000 births and it is estimated that there are about 2,000 living with PWS in the UK. Tiffany a 13 years old girl who suffers from this condition, and her mum have decided to bring awareness to our community. They attend Mass at St Mark's and many of us will know them. They are also fundraising for their charity PWSA UK. This Sunday, at St Mark's they will bring cakes and cupcakes for you to purchase for a donation, after the 12 noon Mass. Please join them.
