TODAY'S MASS

To be forgiven,
you must forgive

Fr Brian writes...

Today's Gospel Matthew 18:21-35

Jesus teaches that we must forgive one another as God has forgiven us.

Last week's Gospel, in which Jesus taught the disciples how to handle disputes and conflict within the Christian community, gets a follow on today. Peter asks Jesus how many times one ought to extend forgiveness to another. Peter proposes a reasonable number of times, perhaps seven. Jesus replies by extending Peter's proposal by an enormous amount; not just seven times should one forgive, but 77 times. Get that! How we struggle with even once – if at all! I usually aim to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation at least once a month, if not more. God allows me to experience how horrible and horrid is my sinfulness to myself, others and the Church, so that he can show me in the Sacrament how much greater is his loving forgiveness. Oh, by the way, when did you last go to Confession!? Anyway, I digress.

Through the parable we hear today we come to understand the depths of God's mercy toward us and the results of our acceptance of God's forgiveness.

There is a temptation to quantify forgiveness as Peter tried to do, but Jesus' point is that forgiveness is not about quantity—the number of times we extend forgiveness to another. In the parable the king's forgiveness is like God's forgiveness, and it transforms us, helping us to be as forgiving as God. The lesson is clear: If we hoard God's mercy while showing no mercy to others, we risk forfeiting the effects of God's mercy in our lives. That would be eternally damning. The ultimate BAD NEWS! So, GO TO CONFESSION!
