TODAY'S MASS 'We have found the Messiah'

"Here I am Lord I come to do your will."

Dear friends

This weekend I start as your new parish priest. I'm looking forward to meeting you in the coming months as I settle into a new life with you.

I will have just returned from Assisi where I tagged along with a group from our Youth Team from SPEC in Pinner. There I have prayed for you and for the people of St Lawrence in Feltham who I will miss for quite a while. God has given me and is giving me a priest's heart. It is a bit of a miracle. 'I will hold your people in my heart' has become a reality as Christ forms me to be his friend and share in his priesthood. I have needed to pray for myself too at the tombs of St Francis and St Clare and also of that extraordinary young man Blessed Carlo Acutis. For all of them their one - or shall we say their main - hope and desire was to be available to God and to love and serve him.

The refrain of the psalm is a verse of self-offering: "Here I am Lord I come to do your will." It is a daring thing to say because we know how weak and willful we can be. But I ask you to join with me in making that offering to the Lord Jesus as a new chapter opens in the life of our parish. Who can I be for you Lord? What do you desire of me Lord?

The Lord Jesus' whole life, death and resurrection is an offering of love to the Father. We commemorate that in the Mass and if we allow ourselves we are drawn into that offering of love to the Father. The sacrifice of the Mass makes present Jesus' offering in the now; and it makes of your offering and mine a reality as he unites us with himself. Only he can do this in us. Well this is what I have found.

So, what is his desire? To draw all people to himself. In the gospel we glimpse his divine invitation to the first bewildered apostles to come and be with him. Come and see. Let that be our mission too - in all we do and seek to achieve. To draw others to him.

Thank you for your welcome. Thank you for trusting the Lord Jesus who brings us together. May the prayers of our patrons Our Lady, St Joseph and St Mark and the prayers St Francis, St Clare and Bl. Carlo win for us the graces we need to be his Body, his living presence for others.
