On Tuesday last week (27 February) the Church celebrated St Gregory of Narek, an Armenian Saint who was made a Doctor of the Church by Pope Francis in 2015.

Pope Francis wrote in 2015, that St Gregory "gave voice to the cry, which became a prayer, of a sinful and sorrowful humanity, oppressed by the anguish of its powerlessness, but illuminated by the splendour of God's love and open to the hope of his salvific intervention, which is capable of transforming all things."

unending sweetness, glorious mildness.

You, over whom compassion prevails, but

do not feel restrained.

**LENTEN MESSAGE FOR THE POPE:** The Pope's Lenten Message for 2024, released on 1 February and entitled 'Through the Desert God Leads us to Freedom', echoes the themes of the Pope's social encyclicals, 'Laudato Si'

and 'Fratelli Tutti'. He calls for "conversion" and urges attention to social justice, review of personal lifestyle, care for creation, and aiding the poor and marginalised. He says: "Today, the cry of so many of our oppressed brothers and sisters rises to heaven. Let us ask ourselves: Do we hear that cry? Does it trouble us? Does it move us? .... Love of God and love of neighbour are one love." LENT: To fast, give alms and pray. Daily prayer is always

an essential element of the Christian spiritual life, but never as important as during Lent.
