

FR RITCHE'S FAREWELL MASS: Fr Ritche's farewell Mass will be on Sunday 23 July and on that occasion we will only have one Mass at 10.30 am followed by a social gathering to celebrate together his years of service in our Parish. After the mass there will be a farewell celebration in the car park where we are going to serve food and give an opportunity to personally wish all the best to Fr Ritche. On that day **the car park will be closed**, please either come on foot or ask a family friend or relative to drop you off.

DRESS CODE: As we are in summertime, a gentle reminder that, on warm days, everyone is required to dress appropriately and modestly when visiting our church. Please make sure that you not wearing anything with a low neckline, sleeveless garments which expose the shoulders, clothing that exposes the knees or upper legs (whether sitting or standing), clothing that exposes the stomach or back, or clothing made of see-through material; also avoid excessively tight clothing. Dress well; you are in the presence of Our Lord, your king.

SUMMER FAYRE RAFFLE: Tickets for the Summer Fayre Raffle are now on sale £1 per tickets or £5 for a book, tickets can be bought after Masses or from the Office. If you wish to help us selling them, please ask the helpers for books. For those who take books with them, please ensure that stubs and money are returned to the Parish Office no later than Wednesday 12 July. The Raffle will be drawn at the end of the Summer Fayre on Saturday 15 July.

SUMMER FAYRE DONATIONS: We are looking for donations of bottles (for the tombola), if you wish you can contribute some Pimm's for our drink stalls, as well as brand new toys, toiletries and gift sets (Soft Toys have to be brand new or washed before being brought to Church). Please bring any donation to the Parish Office by Wednesday 12 July. Please be mindful that we are not a place where you can dump rubbish and expect us to dispose of things.

SACRISTY: The Sacristy is a space for priests and altar servers to be vested and prepare before Mass. We have noticed that a number of people are going in, disregarding the **NO Entry sign** at the door, to speak with the clergy. Please do not enter unless you are authorised, only sacristans, catechists and altar server parents are allowed in. If you need to speak with a priest, please go to the presbytery.

VOTIVE CANDLES: You may have noticed that we have now different votive candle stands; this is due to health and safety concern, as we want to make sure we follow the insurance guidelines. We are on a trial now and we will then make a decision on how many stands we actually need and where as well as their size. Each stand has a lighter with it so please use it to light your candles and not use candles to light other candles, please also refrain from taking candles around the Church, especially lit candles as it poses a risk for yourself and others around you.

ALTAR SERVERS OUTING: We have planned an outing for our Altar Servers on Saturday 22 July at the Airport Bowl. We have booked for 12 pm, as we are not organising transport parents need to make sure you drop off your children 15 minutes before and collect them at the end of our activity, if your children are making their way through public transport we need to be informed beforehand.
