FR RITCHE'S FAREWELL MASS: This Sunday we celebrate Fr Ritche's Farewell Mass at 10.30 am followed by a social gathering to celebrate together his years of service in our Parish. After the mass there will be a farewell celebration in the car park (weather permitting) where we are going to serve food and give an opportunity to personally wish all the best to Fr Ritche. After Mass, on your way out, you can collect from our helpers a food voucher that you can exchange for either a burger or a plate of curry; we will also serve drinks, tea, coffee and cake. There will be envelopes for your donation to Fr Ritche.

DRESS CODE: As we are in summertime, a gentle reminder that, on warm days, everyone is required to dress appropriately and modestly when visiting our church. Please make sure that you not wearing anything with a low neckline, sleeveless garments which expose the shoulders, clothing that exposes the knees or upper legs (whether sitting or standing), clothing that exposes the stomach or back, or clothing made of see-through material; also avoid excessively tight clothing. Dress well; you are in the presence of Our Lord, your king.
