DRESS CODE: As we are in summertime, a gentle reminder that, on warm days, everyone is required to dress appropriately and modestly when visiting our church. Please make sure that you not wearing anything with a low neckline, sleeveless garments which expose the shoulders, clothing that exposes the knees or upper legs (whether sitting or standing), clothing that exposes the stomach or back, or clothing made of see-through material; also avoid excessively tight clothing. Dress well; you are in the presence of Our Lord, your king.

SOLEMNITY OF ST JUSTIN MARIA RUSSOLILLO: On Wednesday 2 August we are celebrating the feast of St Justin Maria Russolillo, the founder of the Vocationist Family.

FR MARK LEENANE RIP: Fr Mark's mortal remains will be received at St Vincent de Paul Church, Osterley at 3pm on Monday 31 July. The church will remain open until 10pm. SACRISTY: The Sacristy is a space for priests and altar servers to be vested and prepare before Mass. Please do not enter unless you are authorised, only sacristans, catechists and altar server parents are allowed in. If you need to speak with a priest, please go to the presbytery.

VOTIVE CANDLES: Each stand has a lighter with it so please use it to light your candles and not use candles to light other candles, please also **refrain from taking candles around the Church**, especially lit candles as it poses a risk for yourself and others around you.

WORLD YOUTH DAY SUMMER PICNIC: Join Westminster Youth Ministry on 2nd September for a taste of Lisbon at their Summer Picnic.
