DONA COLLECTION PLATE: In March last year we acquired a Digital Collection plate and since then we have raised £8733.46, with some donations we have also been able to claim gift-aid. We are extremely grateful for your generosity! We have now acquired two more machines, which you can find by the side door and by the statue of Our Lady. The machine by Our Lady has also an option for your donation towards votive candles.

POLITE NOTICE – If your child becomes noisy and disruptive can you please take them to the room at the back of the church for the duration of the mass. Also, accompany the kneelers when you are using them and do not drop them so to avoid loud noise especially at Consecration time.

SWITCH OFF YOUR PHONE: When you enter the Church, it may be possible that you hear "the call of God". However, it is unlikely that He will call you on your mobile. It may be a good exercise to switch it off or at least put it on silent before you enter the Church. If you want to talk to God, find a quiet place, pray and talk to Him.

CAR PARK: Our Car Park operates on a one-way system with clear signage on the ground. When exiting the car park, cars must pass through the back of the halls. Also, drivers please ensure you drive slowly and pay attention to pedestrians, especially any children, while driving.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS: Throughout the season of Lent we will celebrate the Stations of the Cross every Friday at 6:15 pm.

SACRAMENTS

BAPTISMS: Please use the form on the Parish Website to enquire about the Baptism for your child. We celebrate Baptisms on a Saturday only; we ask that you give us minimum 6 weeks' notice.

MARRIAGE: If you are planning to marry, we can only start the paperwork needed by the diocese 6 months prior your wedding day. Whether you are marrying in the UK or abroad we need minimum 6 months' notice, especially if we need to arrange a marriage course. Please do not leave it to the last minute!

CONFESSIONS: Every Saturday 10-10:45 am and during the Station of the Cross every Friday 6:15-6:45 pm.
