NOTICES

SECOND COLLECTION: This weekend we will hold a second collection for the Easter Flowers.

GOOD FRIDAY COLLECTION: It is the main source of material support for Christian life in the Holy Land and the privileged instrument that the Church provides her children in other parts of the world to express solidarity with the ecclesial communities of the Middle East. Through the funds traditionally collected on Good Friday, the Franciscan Custody of the Holy Land is able to carry out the important mission to which it is called: preserving the Sacred Places, the stones of memory, and promoting the Christian presence, the living stones, through many pastoral, educational, welfare, health and social structures. The territories that benefit in various forms of support from the Collection are Jerusalem, Palestine, Israel, Jordan, Cyprus, Syria, Lebanon, Egypt, Ethiopia, Eritrea, Turkey, Iran and Iraq. As a rule, the Custody of the Holy Land receives 65% of the Collection, while the remaining 35% goes to the Congregation for the Eastern Churches, which uses it for the formation of candidates for the priesthood, the support of the clergy, educational activities, cultural formation and subsidies to the various ecclesiastical circumscriptions in the Middle East.

WALK OF WITNESS: After the pandemic, we are resuming this year the Walk of Witness organised by the Christian Churches in Heston. We are starting the Walk at 9 am from the Methodist Church on Heston Road and stop at St Leonard's Church and finishes here at our Church. After the Walk of Witness, we will gather in the Pope John Centre for Tea and Coffee and Hot Cross Buns.

EASTER FLOWERS: If you have a garden and have long ivy or camellia tree shrubs, we would be grateful if you could donate some of their branches to us so our flower arrangers could use them for Easter Sunday. If you can contribute, please bring it to the parish office by Friday. If no one is in the house, please leave it by the door and we will take care of it as soon as possible.

EASTER RAFFLE: Tickets for our Easter raffle are on sale, £1 per ticket or £5 for the book. If you are taking a book home please make sure you return it by 26 March. The raffle will be drawn on Easter Sunday at the end of the 9:30 am Mass. All proceeds will go towards the Building Fund.

CAR PARK: On Palm Sunday and during the Easter Triduum, the front of the Church will be closed to the traffic. Please use the rear entrance to the car park, also consider walking to Church or ask for a lift to Church.

DRESS CODE: A gentle reminder that, when coming to Church, we need to dress appropriately as we are in a place of worship. Please make sure that you not wearing anything with a low neckline, sleeveless garments which expose the shoulders, clothing that exposes the knees or upper legs (whether sitting or standing), clothing that exposes the stomach or back, or clothing made of see-through material; also avoid excessively tight clothing. Dress well; you are in the presence of Our Lord, your king.

GIFT AID ENVELOPES: The envelopes can be collected from the Parish Office, please note that due to GDPR we cannot leave these at the back of the Church. If you ask someone else to collect on your behalf, please let us know in advance.

SACRAMENTS

BAPTISMS: Please use the form on the Parish Website to enquire about the Baptism for your child. We celebrate Baptisms on a Saturday only; we ask that you give us minimum 6 weeks' notice.

Whether you are marrying in the UK or abroad we need minimum 6 months' notice, especially if we need to arrange a marriage course. Please do not leave it to the last minute!
