This month we will be collecting on $9^{th}/10^{th}$ April. There are four staples urgently required:

- 1 Cartons of semi-skimmed UHT milk with an expiry date of three months minimum. ½ litre size preferred.
- 2 Powdered milk with an expiry date of at least three months.
- 3 Packets of powdered potato with an expiry date of three months minimum. (4 packs £1 at Sainsbury)
- 4 Tinned potatoes, any size, with an expiry date of three months minimum.

We do not have room for storage here, so please only bring items on the designated days. They should be placed in the brown box, labelled FOODBANK, in the porch.
