CORONAVIRUS UPDATE

- The Chalice has been suspended.
- No Offertory Procession or Sign of Peace.
- We will not be using hymn books or Mass books to prevent the transfer of infection from hand to hand.
- Please take a newsletter but DO NOT put it back in the tray. Please also DO NOT leave it in the pews. Take it home with you and dispose of it there.
- In view of advice from the Diocese not to serve food and drink at communal gatherings, there will be no coffee mornings until further notice.

Please remember to wash your hands before and after you come to church. Because of lack of supplies, we are unable to offer hand gel at the church – please bring your own supply if you can – and use it regularly!

Deacon Reg and I will be unable to shake hands at the door – please be aware that all these measures are not a cause for anxiety, but to help us contain the virus.
