#### **CORONAVIRUS UPDATE**

As you may already know the Bishops Conference of England and Wales has now told us we are not able to hold "public gatherings" for the foreseeable future.

However, the Cardinal has also requested that the churches be open at certain times to allow you to come and pray. Therefore, St Bernadette's will be open on Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday between 10.30 am – 12 noon, and on Sundays between 10 – 12 noon. Please come and pray in solitude for a while – but please do not sit within 2 metres of each other!
