CHURCH REOPENING

It is the Cardinal's hope that our churches should reopen for "individual prayer" sometime in June. However, this would be under the strictest conditions in line with the Government's medical advice.

There will be an entrance and an exit door and we will be expected to obey the two metre distance rule from one another. Certain sections of the church will be cordoned off and you will be unable to light a candle, or use the toilet. As the church will be in use for quiet prayer only no prayer groups can be allowed, not even for the Rosary, which may be said silently.
