CHURCH REOPENING

It is the Cardinal's hope that our churches should reopen for "individual prayer" sometime in June or early July. However, this would be under the strictest conditions in line with the Government's medical advice.

There will be an entrance and an exit door and we will be expected to obey the two metre distance rule from one another. Certain sections of the church will be cordoned off and you will be unable to light a candle, or use the toilet. As the church will be in use for quiet prayer only no prayer groups can be allowed, not even for the Rosary, which may be said silently.

We are being asked to create teams of volunteer stewards to encourage you to keep to the rules, and cleaners, who would disinfect the church after every session. Protective clothing and cleaning items are being purchased to assist with this task. We would ask you to consider volunteering for either of these roles – bearing in mind that volunteers must be under 70 years of age and with no underlying health conditions.
