

This Weekend: Remembrance Sunday We have the Inscription Masses for the Families on the Reconciliation and First Eucharist Programme, at the 6.00pm Mass and 10.30am Masses. We pray for our families as they embark on this Journey of Preparation.

We will be holding the **2 Minute Silence**, as near as possible to 11.00am, as an introduction to the Inscription of the Children onto the Sacramental Programme for this year, as a celebration for the values and ideals for which so many gave their lives.
