Churches Together (CTH) is organising three things: Pulpit exchanges on Sundays 12 and 19 January when congregations will welcome a minister from a different church.

**19<sup>th</sup> January 6.30pm** Joint Ecumenical Service at St Mary's: "Communion under One Roof" The main Celebration will be an Anglican Eucharist with involvement of many people and any Catholics who wish to receive Communion during this Celebration may do so from St Andrew's Chapel, where Fr Michael will be offering them Communion from the Reserved Sacrament in our Church. It will include 'communion under one roof' and induction/welcome for Jane Litchmore-Grant of The Church of God of Prophecy as Chair of CTH. Jane will be the preacher on this occasion. This is one of the main Celebrations we hold in our town on an ecumenical basis and it would be good to see as many of you as possible come along and join in. We will also be taking our CTH Banner from the Church for the occasion, anyone wishing to carry the Banner in the entry Procession is more than welcome to come along at 5.30pm for a "walk-through" of what happens.
