## Monday 3 March

7.30pm: Our Parish Pastoral Council is continuing its Session of preparation for creating links which will be a more visible way of linking with parishioners, who have questions or concerns, so that they can be dealt with more swiftly by the appropriate person or Group. Various items have been raised for discussion. The first item is regarding COMMUNICATION. As a parish we have had problems with various group and individuals and we do not have a clear procedure for resolving matters. The other important item discussed at length was Archbishop Vincent's vision for the future of the Diocese, called GROWING IN FAITH, which presents his aims of better supporting the sick and retired Clergy; the training of future Priests; the life and development of each parish and finally, supporting the work of charities, uniquely based in the area of the Diocese, under the aegis of Caritas. The parish is called to share in this project and we have been asked to start after Easter 2014.

More details will be available nearer the start time and also about a visit from our Area Bishop, John, will make to us, to help us enter more fully into the vision the Archbishop has for his Diocese..

# Wednesday 5 March

Ash Wednesday, marking the opening of the Season of Renewal of Lent. There are three Masses to celebrate this important day in our faith development: All Masses are in the Church: at 7.30am; 10.00am and 7.30pm. There is a Service of Blessing and Distribution of Ashes at the School, starting at 2.30pm, to which Parents and Parishioners are also invited. Today, is a Day of FASTING as well as Abstinence, for those who are asked to do those exercises of devotion. This time of reflection is an opportunity for us to look at our lives of faith and how they might move forward in new ways: reading and praying the Scriptures; the Teachings of the Church; acts of charity for others whom we know to be in need. These can be strengthened by acts of self-denial, to allow us to grow and move forward - they are not simply things we have always "given up" which can often be an excuse for losing weight! \*\*\*\*\*\*

On this day also. Fr Michael celebrates 48 years in the Priesthood. So do please hold him in your prayer, as he overcomes the effects of shingles and the infection that marked the New Year. He is due to have a gastroscopy in the coming week or two.
