Congo Micro-hydropower The Assumptionists of the Province of Africa would like to thank the One World group members in our parish and all those parishioners who have supported with their contributions the project in Fr Jean-Marie's village in Congo. We have been able to find a 100 Kw turbine, a key part to produce electricity. The turbine has reached the Congo from Italy where it was made. A big thank you to, Michael and Deolinda Eltringham, who were able to raise three thousand euros (€3,000) from Henkel AG & Co. KGaA company in Germany for this project. We thank in a particular way donors from Italy who took over the project and paid for the shipping of the turbine from Italy to the Congo ********
