# offertory Appeal Results

Update – "One Year On"

It is now over a year since our Offertory Appeal, which was 2013, and we would like to update

held in October 2013, and we would like to update you on the results.

The good news is that, overall, we have seen a 16% increase in Offertory income – up from just over £108,000 in the year ending October 2013 to nearly £125,000 in the year ending October 2014.

The not so good news is that we have seen the level of the increase fall away quite dramatically over the course of the year from about +20% at the start to just +5% at the end with the most significant hit being in the Loose Plate income, which is now well below 2013 levels.

So, a further big "thank you" to all of you who have responded so positively to the Offertory Appeal and have kept up your donations. If, for whatever reason, you have not been able to keep up your donations, we understand that and would just ask that you bear in mind your support for the Parish when you are next in a position to do so.
