It is a great sadness that to inform you that we have been told of the deaths of the three kidnapped Assumptionist Priests, Fathers Jean-Pierre NDULANI, Edmond KISUGHU and Anselme WASUKUNDI, in the Congo for whom we have been praying over the past two and a half years. There are two independent reports that the Priests were kidnapped and had refused to convert to Islam and were killed within three days of their imprisonment. Although they still have corroboration of these reports, it is looking more and more grim. It is possible that, if they did refuse to convert to Islam and were killed because of their convictions, they are martyrs for the faith. Please keep them in your prayers as well as their families and our brothers in the Province of Africa. We will arrange to have a special Mass to pray for them. Martyrs of the Congo pray for us.
