We will shortly be submitting the tax rebate claim for money donated to the Church under the Gift Aid Scheme in the tax year ending April 2015. If you have signed up for Gift Aid but no longer pay tax, please inform our Planned Giving & Gift Aid Organiser - David Wilson on 01462-627784 - so that we do not submit an inappropriate claim. If you are not sure whether or not you have signed up for Gift Aid or whether you have paid enough tax to cover what we will claim. David will be able to let you know. Similarly, if you have not yet signed up for Gift Aid, but would like to do so, it is not too late and you should contact David. Also, can we take this opportunity to remind you that a Gift Aid donation must be made in the name of the person who pays the tax on the money that is donated; if that is not the case, please let David know and alternative arrangements can be made. We again thank all of you who have signed such an important part in financing the running of the Church.
