PARISH FINANCES 2015

The Parish Accounts for the first half of 2015 show an operating surplus of £9,982.60. This figure is ahead of the budget forecast for the year and we are, therefore, doing better than expected. Unfortunately, we are now starting to see a sharp decline in Offertory income and, if this continues at the current rate, we will soon be in a deficit position again. It is important, therefore, that we all review what we give to support the running of the Church and, if we are in a position to do so, adjust our offerings accordingly.
