Ramblings for Reflection: When I was growing up we had an outdoor procession for Corpus Christi (the Body & Blood of Christ) every year with the children who had made their first communion strewing flower petals on the road before the Blessed Sacrament. We wanted everyone to know how proud we were of our God and of Jesus' love for us, wanting to share our joy and praise with them. Jesus shares his love and life with us in a concrete way through the host and the wine that has become his Body and Blood, just like someone showing their love for us when they embrace or kiss us. It is in the contact that we experience the depth of that love and in which that love enters into and strengthens our lives. Just as we believe the bread and wine are transformed (transubstantiation) into the Body and Blood of Jesus in Holy Communion, we assimilate this same Jesus. The love and life that it offers penetrates and transforms our whole being. No wonder we cannot have enough of this wondrous and transforming gift!!

We pray for Ted Hollingdale who died on Thursday. Ted was a governor at Our Lady's for over 20 years. His service to the school and parish has been greatly valued
