Ramblings for Reflection: The mathematician in me thinks: Wow! They went to 36 towns and villages (the 72). They did not have a particularly good understanding of Jesus. There's no indication that they received any special formation apart from journeying with Jesus: listening seeing, experiencing Jesus. No exams or qualifications needed or required. But, Jesus had confidence in them, trusted them, and they knew it and probably set out before they even asked themselves: What have I let myself in for?? Then they come back full of joy. Do you see a connection?
